Good time to grab the bargain! Ciaotou District Prosecutors Office will hold a ship auction on January 28, and welcome the willing vendors and people to join in the grand event.

Taiwan Ciaotou District Prosecutors Office will publicly auction two sand pump dredgers, "Haihang 5679" and "Haisheng 877". Due to the perpetrator's violation of the Law on the Exclusive Economic Zone and the Continental Shelf of the Republic of China, the court adjudged to confiscate the two sand pump dredgers. The two sand pump dredgers are currently moored at the sixth dock of Xingda Port for the authorities in Qiding District, Kaohsiung City. They were still in serviceable status at the time of the seizure (June 3, 2020, July 30, 2020).

"Haihang 5679" has a gross tonnage of 7,569 tons, a total length of 139.8 meters, a beam molded of 23.3 meters, and a molded depth of 7.8 meters. "Haisheng 877" has a gross tonnage of 4,448 tons, a total length of 103.88 meters, a beam molded of 20.2 meters, and a molded depth of 6 meters. The vendors and people who are willing to participate in the bidding can go to the sixth dock of Xingda Port for the authorities in Qiding District, Kaohsiung City from 9:30 am to 11:00 am on January 25, 2021, and be guided to watch by the coast guard staff (To board the ship to watch, the visitors must contact the coast guard staff before 5:00 pm on January 22, 2021).
